New partnership

The Racing Force Group announced this morning that it has signed a new agreement with Maserati MSG Racing for the FIA Formula E World Championship.

While Maserati announced in April 2022 that it was partnering with ROKiT Venturi Racing to enter the Formula E World Championship, the new team's drivers will wear OMP safety equipment. The ninth season of Formula E will start on 14 January 2023 with the E-Prix in Mexico City.

The new Formula E season will see the introduction of a new generation of singleseaters: Gen3. In addition to benefiting from new power that can take them up to 270km/h, this new generation of vehicles also offers improved environmental performance, with 40% of the energy used during the race coming from regenerative braking.

This is a prestigious new agreement for Racing Force in a championship that has been attracting increasing audiences for several years and which should be boosted by the appearence of the Gen3 next season.

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This Report may mention evaluation methods defined as follows:

1. DCF method: discounting of future cash flows generated by the company's operations. Cash flows are determined by the analyst's financial forecasts and models. The discount rate used corresponds to the weighted average cost of capital, which is defined as the weighted average cost of the company's debt and the theoretical cost of its equity as estimated by the analyst.

2. Comparable method: application of market valuation multiples or those observed in recent transactions. These multiples can be used as references and applied to the company's financial aggregates to deduce its valuation. The sample is selected by the analyst based on the characteristics of the company (size, growth, profitability, etc.). The analyst may also apply a premium/discount depending on his perception of the company's characteristics.

3. Assets and liabilities method: estimate of the value of equity capital based on revalued assets adjusted for the value of the debt.

4. Discounted dividend method: discounting of estimated future dividend flows. The discount rate used is generally the cost of capital.5. Sum of the parts: this method consists of estimating the various activities of a company using the most appropriate valuation method for each of them, then realizing the sum of the parts.
